
Instruction for Solvent-based White

[Handling Instruction]


- 1. Store the cartridge with its nozzles up as shown in Photo 1.
- 2. Before installing the cartridge in a printer, shake the cartridge up and down for **30 seconds** with the nozzles down as shown in Photo 2 to maintain optimal printing conditions.
 - Do not shake the cartridge strongly. It may cause damage to the ink cartridge.
- 3. After shaking the cartridge, remove its cover and wipe extra ink with a lint-free dry cloth as shown in Photo 3.
 - Do not wipe the nozzles with water.
 - When the nozzles are dirty with ink, clean the print head with a lint-free cloth.







Conduct a printing performance test before running it.
If the performance is not satisfactory, follow instruction 2, 3, and 4 again.



5. After every use, to prevent nozzles drying out, wipe excess ink again with a lint-free dry cloth and cover the cartridge with its original clip. Make sure the cartridge is stored "Nozzle Up".



- 6. Please use both nozzle rows for printing operation.
- 7. When the cartridge is not used for more than one hour, please store the cartridge with its cover and store "Nozzle Up".

Caution

- 1. The whiteness may vary during printing due to the nature of the ink.
- 2. The white ink cartridge may show nozzle missing on daily use. Please shake and wipe the cartridge by following this instruction when it happens.
